

COMMUNITY REGULATIONS

GREENE HILLS FAMILY CAMPGROUND AND RV PARK

1. Quiet hours are from 11 p.m. until 7 a.m. Electronic entertainment devices must be at a volume that cannot be heard beyond the site. An adult must supervise children at all times.
2. The minimum age for renting a site is 18 years.
3. Checkout is 2:00pm. The check-in time is 3 pm. The management will assign all Campsites. Management reserves the right to charge additional fees to persons wishing to extend time beyond checkout.
4. Maximum of two pets per campsite are permitted on a leash only. At no time are pets to be unattended. Pets will not be allowed to become a nuisance to other guests (including barking). Guests are responsible for cleaning up after their pets anywhere on the grounds. Pets are prohibited from entering the restroom/shower house facility. It is expected that all pets have current rabies vaccinations.
5. Campfires are to be limited to the fire rings provided and not moved.
6. The operation of chain saws and the cutting or carving of any sized trees is strictly prohibited.
7. Neither the removal of hot water from the restroom, nor the use of the restrooms for washing dishes, utensils or clothing is permitted.
8. The washing of vehicles and campers is not permitted at the Greene Hills RV Park.
9. The dumping of waste water anywhere other than in the designated Dumping Station is strictly prohibited and against PA state regulations.
10. If you use waste water treatment chemicals, please choose products that contain no formaldehyde. Please use a biodegradable chemical.
11. All trash is to be deposited in the dumpster when you vacate your site. The dumpster is located conveniently near the exit of the park.
12. The use of alcoholic beverages, firearms (including BB & Pellet guns), Fireworks or illegal drugs is strictly prohibited, and will result in immediate expulsion from the property.
13. Entrance to the Little Juniata River for any reason will be at your own risk. The Susquehanna Conference of the United Methodist Church, its Camping and Retreats Commission, nor any of the agents of the conference will assume any responsibility or liability whatsoever for persons who enter the river. Please respect the privacy of site residents and use public campground areas for access.
14. Recreational All Terrain Vehicles may not be operated on Greene Hills Camp property. We ask that vehicular traffic on the grass be limited to as seldom as possible.
15. Failure to leave the campsite in the same condition as the site was found when rented is reason for refusal of requests for future reservations or rental.
16. Please be respectful of other campers and the sites they are on. Do not take shortcuts through the other sites or remove items from those sites without permission.
17. The picnic pavilion is for general use, unless advance reservations have been made.
18. There will be only one pop-up or RV unit per site, and each site is permitted a maximum of 5 lodgers per night per base rate.
19. Because of limited parking space, only 1 motor vehicle allowed per site (not including camper unit). Please use the overflow parking area whenever possible.
20. Guests who are not visiting a registered campsite are required to register at the campground office and obtain a \$5/day parking permit which is to be displayed on the dashboard of the vehicle.
21. Firewood, located in the woodshed across from the bathhouse is \$7/wagon load. Payment is on the honor system and may be deposited in the wooden box on the inside wall of the woodshed.
22. Bagged ice and ice cream products are located in the freezers by the bath house. Payment is on the honor system and is to be deposited in the labeled depository on the wall of the bathhouse.
23. The campground washer and dryer are available for camper use Tuesdays through Saturdays. Payment is to be made in the black box on the wall above the dryer. Campers are expected to provide their own laundry products and be sure that the machines and filters are cleaned for the next use. No dyes or bleaches are permitted to be used.
24. Camper rental is subject to PA State Sales Tax for nightly and weekly stays.

Expulsion from the Property - The management reserves the right to request persons to leave the grounds for the non-compliance of any of the above community regulations. Failure to comply with the request to vacate will constitute trespassing, resulting in the management notifying the proper authorities.

NOTICE: The management reserves the right to deny access to the campgrounds to anyone or any group that did not comply with the above community regulations on prior occasions.
